

What To Bring Checklist

Life at camp is simple. Please do not bring too much. Bringing more than what you need will be a great burden. Your belongings are not insured by camp -- valuables should be left at home. Your gear should be compact and carry-able! You will be able to wash clothing on a weekly basis at the local laundromat.

CLOTHING:

- Hiking boots or walking shoes. These should be sturdy, well broken-in, and capable of keeping your feet dry when walking through wet grass, muddy trails and snow.
- Cowboy boot or sturdy shoes with a 1/2" heel for horseback riding.
- 1 pair of shoes (tennis shoes or other)
- Cool clothes: shorts, t-shirts, light jacket, cotton socks (no tank tops during the week of camp)
- Warm clothes: jeans, turtleneck, long-sleeve shirts, sweater, sweatshirts, fleece, wool socks
- Warm jacket or coat (nights can get down to 40 degrees)
- Hat & gloves for warmth
- 1 pair long underwear
- Lightweight nylon rain parka / rain gear -- the program continues, rain or shine!
- Hat for sun / cowboy hat
- Work gloves
- Bandanas
- 1 set of nice clothing

OTHER ITEMS TO BRING:

- Sleeping bag (good to 32 degrees) and pillow -- packed in water-proof stuff bag or garbage bag (If you want to use sheets, bring for a single size bed)
- Soap and shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- The copy of Personnel Policies, Bible Study, and other materials you were sent.
- Notebook, pens
- Bible
- Personal items, medications
- Chapstick, sunscreen
- Towel and washcloth
- Driver's license and social security card, or a passport (For filling out I-9 form)
- Daypack or fanny pack
- Flashlight and batteries
- Wind-up or battery alarm clock
